

Resurrectional Hymn (Plagal of the First Tone)

Eternal with the Father and the Spirit is the Word, who of a virgin: was begotten for our salvation. As the faithful we both praise and: worship Him, for in the flesh did He consent to ascend unto the: Cross, and death did He endure and He raised unto life the dead: through His all glorious resurrection.

Entrance Hymn (Second Tone): Come, let us bow down to Christ, as we: worship Him, the Son of God. Save us, O Son of God, who are risen from:

the dead. We sing to You, "Alleluia!"

Hymn of St. John Chrysostom (Plagal of the Fourth Tone)

The grace of your words has enlightened the universe like a shining beacon. It: :has shown to the world the riches of poverty and revealed to us the heights of: :humility. Therefore, teaching us by your own words, Father John Chrysostom,: intercede with the Word, Christ our God, to save our souls.

·Hymn of St. John the Baptizer (Second Tone)

:A righteous man is remembered with praise, for you Forerunner the Lord's witness is: enough. You were shown to be greater in honor than the prophets, being privileged to: baptize in the stream the One you had foretold. Therefore, rejoicing, you suffered for the: :sake of truth, and proclaimed the good news to those in Hades, that God had appeared in: the flesh to take away the sin of the world, and grant our souls His great mercy.

Kontakion Hymn of the Entrance of the Theotokos (Fourth Tone)

The all-pure temple of the Savior, the most precious bridal-chamber and virgin, the treasure house of the glory of God, today enters the Temple of the Lord, bringing with: her the grace which is in the divine Spirit. She whom the angels of God also celebrate in :song is the heavenly tabernacle.

Church School classes will meet following Holy Communion and end at 12:00 noon.


